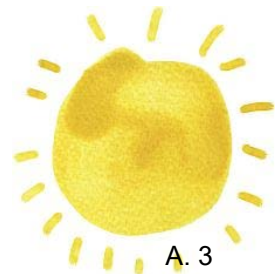

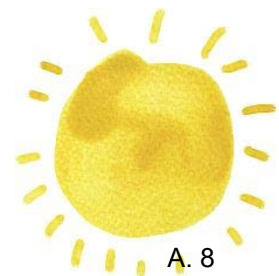
Community Engagement
