Excused						Mr. Mikolai welcomed everyone to the April Board Work Session and called the meeting to order.	Convened: 6:00 p.m.
						1. Licensed Personnel Matter – Mr. Steve Schultz	
						Superintendent Schultz read a statement to the Board recommending the dismissal of a teacher. This is a formal step taken, per state statute,	
						governing these proceedings.	
						 Athletics Updates (numbers, GPA's, attendance rates) – Mr. Paul Cain, District 51 Athletic Director 	
						Mr. Cain thanked the Board for the opportunity to discuss the athletic	
						program in District 51. Mr. Cain presented information and data on high school and middle school athletics. He discussed student-athlete GPA	
						statistics and academic achievement.	
						Mr. Cain discussed SB40 (head trauma bill) and the training District athletic staff have to undergo to detect and treat head traumas. He described the	
						process athletes go through in order to return to play after a head trauma.	
						Mr. Cain was proud to announce, so far this year, District 51 has had 22 student athletes sign national letters of intent to play sports in college.	
						 The Athletic Department also works closely with local businesses to establish 	
						and maintain a scholarship fund to help student athletes afford equipment to	
						play sports. ➤ The Grand Junction Rockies organization has committed to purchasing two	
						sets of uniforms for our high school softball and baseball teams over the next	
						 eight years. This is an approximate \$96,000 investment in our schools. ➤ The Board and Superintendent thanked Mr. Cain for the report. 	
						 3. 2012-2013 School Calendar Discussion ➢ The Board discussed the 2012-2013 school calendar. It was through the 	
						collaborative work of MVEA with District Administrative staff the calendar was	
						presented. The team worked to deliver a calendar to the Board which has the interests of students, parents and teachers at heart.	
						The proposed calendar is very similar to the current 2011-2012 school	
						calendar, with student contact days remaining the same. Inservice days (professional learning) and workdays are slightly adjusted. Spring Break was	
						the major change proposed. It will occur the last week of March so TCAP	
						(Transitional Colorado Assessment Program) testing will be completed prior to Spring Break. The five days employee contracts were reduced over the	
						previous two years, were also highlighted on the calendar. Conference dates	
						were separated in May for secondary and elementary schools to meet the different needs of those grade levels.
