Discussion and comments included the following topics: "School of Choice" if a school was built at Glade Park, the number of students involved, the possibility of a charter school, busing, start & end times, water issues, staffing, fire and emergency services, and financing information. Tentative information was given by members of the Glade Park community group that a donor has expressed an interest in providing land and resources for the school.
