Intergovernmental Agreement Town of Palisade Old Palisade High School Facility

Board of Education Resolution: 07/08-35

RESOLUTION

(Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Palisade Concerning Transfer and Lease Back of the Old Palisade High School Facility)

WHEREAS, the District owns real property situated in the Town of Palisade, Mesa County, Colorado ("Town"), known as the Old Palisade High School and described as follows:

Blocks 2 and 3, Jordan's Addition to the Town of Palisade, County of Mesa, State of Colorado.

("Property") subject to a lease of a portion of the Property to the Mesa County Library having 10-year term from June 1, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the District currently uses only portions of the Property, namely, the Annex Building, now referred to as "Valley School East," having approximately 4,925 square feet, a storage area of approximately 4,586 square feet, and exterior sidewalks and parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined that the remainder of the Property will not be needed in the foreseeable future for any educational purpose authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, the Town proposes that the District convey the Property to the Town, subject to the Library lease, in exchange for which the Town will lease back rent free for a term of ten (10) years those portions of the Property currently used by the District, or comparable space and accommodations, with the Town paying certain utility and maintenance expenses during the primary term, granting the District an option to renew the lease for an additional five (5) year term at a reasonable rental rate; and

WHEREAS, the Town further proposes to permit use of portions of the Property, during the term of the lease for future bilingual education classes, and other community meeting and learning activities; and

WHEREAS, an intergovernmental agreement for such purpose is authorized pursuant to Section 18, Article XIV of the Colorado Constitution, Section 29-1-203, C.R.S., Section 22-32-110(1)(f), C.R.S., and other applicable laws; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent and the Town Manager, with the assistance of legal counsel for the District and the Town, have drafted an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") to

accomplish the foregoing, which IGA they have recommend for approval to their respective governing boards, a copy of said IGA being attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of Mesa County Valley School District No. 51 approves the attached IGA concerning the transfer and lease back of the Old Palisade High School facility to the Town of Palisade; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the President and Secretary of the Board be authorized and directed to execute, in the Board's behalf, the IGA, the Contract to Convey Real Estate, and the Lease Agreement, together with such other instruments as may be necessary and convenient to the accomplishment of the purposes and intent of this Resolution.
